

## Derwent World Patents Library

Due to the evolving nature of Internet technology, there may be recent changes to the Westlaw interface and functionality that are not reflected in this documentation.

The DWPL database contains over 10 million patent family documents covering more than 20 million patents issued from 40 international authorities. Coverage of patents varies by country, and extends as far back as 1963.

Each document represents a patent family and describes where an invention is patented worldwide. Each document contains the basic patent number with a Kind Code (describing the status of the patent) and the date of the patent. The basic patent is typically the first patent issued on the invention and is the first patent listed on each document, while later patents from other authorities for that same invention are added to the document as equivalents. Each document will contain a title, rewritten and translated to English by Derwent patent experts.

Documents may also contain a Derwent produced abstract of the invention, Title Terms, a Derwent Patent Classification, and an image selected by Derwent experts as representative of the patent.
